**BRESNAN ONLINE CUSTOMERS TO RECEIVE 3.0Mbps SERVICE
AT NO ADDITIONAL COST**

Downstream Speeds Set To Double By July 1, 2004

Purchase, New York, June 29, 2004 – Bresnan Communications announced today that by July 1, 2004, it will double its downstream speeds for the majority of its residential Internet customers, allowing them to take full advantage of all the Internet has to offer, at an even faster rate. Downstream speeds will increase from 1.5Mbps to 3.0Mbps, at no additional cost. Residential customers will now have access to speeds that are more than ten times faster than Qwest's standard DSL service (256Kbps), and more than twice as fast as any other available residential service. Upstream speeds will remain the same at 256Kbps. The speed increase will be automatic; no action will be required by Bresnan customers.

The faster service will be available by July 1, 2004 in the following markets:

Colorado: Craig, Delta, Durango, Ft. Morgan, Montrose and Sterling

Montana: Billings, Bozeman, Butte, Dillon, Havre, Hamilton, Kalispell, Livingston, Missoula and Polson

Utah: Cedar City

Wyoming: Buffalo, Cheyenne, Cody, Gillette, Jackson, Lander, Laramie, Powell, Riverton, Sheridan and Thermopolis

According to Lenny Higgins, Bresnan's Senior Vice President for Advanced Services, "Bresnan is continually making improvements to our Internet service. In the last year, we've launched 35 new markets, added new features and improved e-mail virus protection and spam filtering. This increased speed is just another example how we continue to add value to our service."

Bresnan Communications is nearing completion of a two-year, \$200 million upgrade of its cable systems. By year-end, the company anticipates that its high-speed Internet service will be available to over 97% of its customer base. It expects to launch the faster service in nearly all other markets in the fourth quarter of 2004.

The Bresnan OnLine high-speed Internet service provides customers with a portal customized specifically for the region, six e-mail addresses and up to 10Mbps of personal web space. Bresnan offers a full-service professional installation in a single visit and provides 24 hours/7 days a week customer service.
